Year 3 Fundamentals of Reading

Word reading

* I can decode new words, testing out ways of saying them and correct myself where needed based on my own experience i.e. tetchnical -> technical.

Root words/ prefixes & suffixes

* I apply my knowledge of root words, prefixes and suffixes to help me read aloud and to understand the meaning of new words

Word meaning

* I use dictionaries to check the meaning of new words & I can read and explain the meaning of words in context.

Sight Vocabulary

* I can read red words and notice the of tricky bits

Deduction

- * I check the text makes sense to me by discussing my understanding
- * I ask questions to make the meaning clear
 - * I can find, and record information from non-fiction.

Prediction

* I can predict what might happen from details in the story

Inference

- * I can infer characters feelings, thoughts and motives from their actions.
- * I can justify my inferences with evidence from the text
- * I can show how I understand figurative language

Purpose/ Evaluation

Fluency
