Year 3 Fundamentals of Writing

Whole Word Spelling

- * I can spell more than 50 of the Year 3/4 commonly misspelt words correctly. I can spell:
 - words ending –sion, -ure and *ei* (-eigh/-ey),
 - words with 'y' within them
 - words with ou (-uh)

Apostrophes

* I can place the possessive apostrophe accurately in words with regular and irregular plurals.

The boy's pen—The boys' pens
The child's pen—The children's pens

Joined Handwriting

* I can use diagonal and horizontal strokes to join letters and I know which letters are best left un-joined when they are next to each other

Suffixes & Prefixes

- * I can:
- add suffixes (ing, er, en, ed) to words with more than 1 syllable
- use and understand the suffixes:
- -ation, -ly and -ous
- use and understand the prefixes: un-, dis-, mis- and in-

Vocabulary, Grammar & Punctuation

Word, Sentence, Text

- * I can use a and an (articles) correctly
- * I can express time, place and cause using conjunctions, adverbs and prepositions
- * I can extend sentences, with more than one clause, by using a wide range of conjunctions
- * I can use the present perfect form of verbs (I have played, I have been playing)

Punctuation

* I can use inverted commas (speech marks) to punctuate direct speech

Being a Writer (composition)

Organisation & Planning

- * I can use our shared models of writing when planning, discussing & recording my ideas
- * I can identify the audience & purpose of a piece of writing

Draft & Write

- * I can compose & practise sentences orally
- * I can paragraphs to group related ideas (and include headings/subheading for non-fiction)
- * I can create characters, setting and plots in my story writing

Evaluate & Edit

- * I can proof read for spelling, grammar and punctuation errors
- * I can suggest ideas & (make) improvements to my own and others' writing
- * I can make changes to pronouns and nouns to avoid repetition

Discussing & Sharing Writing

- * I can read my own writing out loud using the right intonation, tone and volume
- * I can identify the grammar rules used in my own writing and books I am reading
