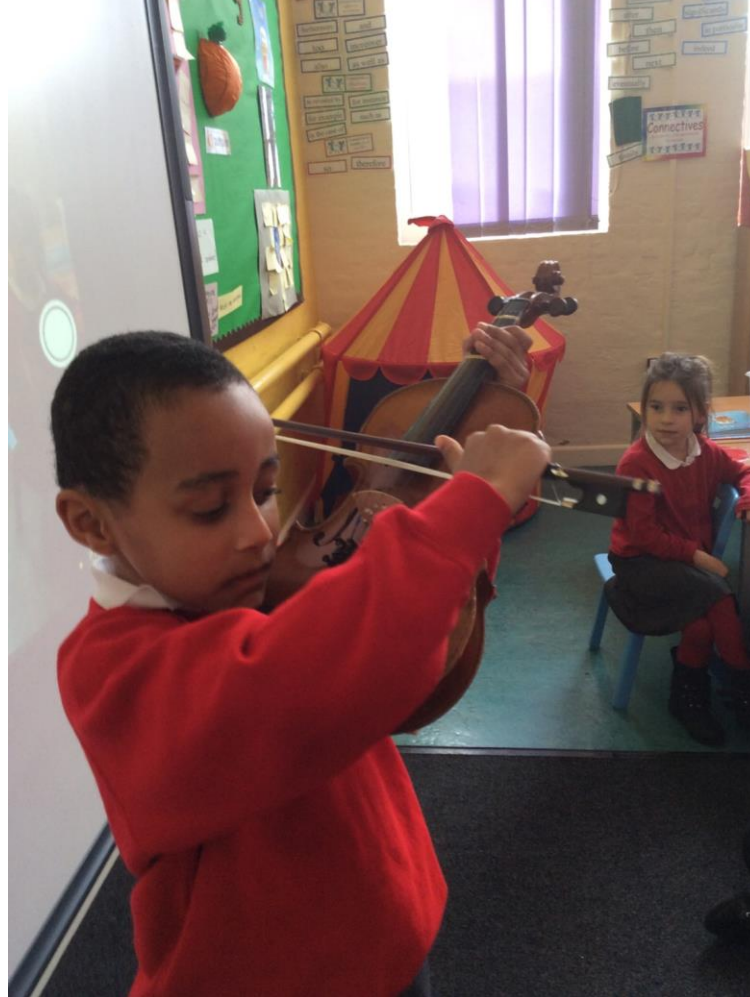


During the Autumn term 2021, we had a drum club every Wednesday at lunchtime.

Regular in school concerts put music at the heart of our school.



We have performed concerts in other schools such as Clapton School for Girls, City Academy and Gainsborough Primary School.
